RE: Friday, November 20, 2020 – Courtesy Notification

Dear SF Day - Golden Gate Avenue and Central Neighbors:

We are entering a major milestone for the SF Day Construction Project – the concrete pour of the basement slab-on-grade. We wanted to provide a courtesy notification of work that will be taking place on Friday, November 20, 2020.

This work will take most of the day. There will be noise in the early hours of 6am to 7am while the Contractor removes the fencing and completes the site set-up for the day (they will make every effort to stay as quiet as possible). The noise level will be moderate throughout the day; similar to the normal construction work day. The block will be very busy with truck activity. Please see the schedule listed below:

- **6am – Concrete Pump Arrives**
- **7am – First Concrete Truck Arrives**
- **7am – 3pm – Concrete Pumping** - Trucks will be on a 15-minute schedule (4 per hour) with two trucks unloading into the pump at a time. We expect somewhere between 25-30 total trucks.
- **3pm – 4pm – Concrete Pump Cleanout**
- **3pm – 8pm – Concrete Finishing:** Work during these hours will be quiet with very little noise other than workers speaking to each other
- **8pm – Estimated Completion**
